Gulf Coast Sports Challenge

General Rules and Information

2019

1. Eligibility :

Employees eligible to participate in the Gulf Coast Sports Challenge must be based in the Harris/Galveston county area. Employees must receive minimum benefits from their Company and must have worked at least ninety (90) days before September 07, 2019. This includes employees at other branches that may be located outside of Harris/Galveston County. Ex: Company is based in Deer Park but there is a branch in Friendswood/another county.

Exceptions to the Eligibility:

- *All Athletes must be 15 years of age by September 1, 2019. Under 17 must have their parent/legal guardian playing on the team as well.*
- *Transferred Employees that have worked for their Company for more than ninety (90) days are eligible to participate.*
- *Retired Employees are eligible to participate. Must be receiving benefits from that Company.*
- *Contract Labor is eligible to participate to compete with ninety (90) days of employment on site and they do not work at another site during the past ninety days. (We discourage this but will accept if regular employment base is low in participation).*
- *Sons and Daughters are eligible to participate.*
- *Grandchildren of employees are eligible to participate.*
- *Spouses are eligible to participate.*
- *All athletes must be an amateurs.*

Note: Eligibility of an athlete rests with the Assistant Director, Athletic Supervisor with the City of Deer Park, Gulf Coast Challenge Committee Member, Company Coordinator, or Tournament Director.

2. Fees:

*All applicable fees must be paid by **Friday, August 31, 2019**. The fee for the each Company is \$875. Please make checks payable to: "City of Deer Park" Gulf Coast Sports Challenge. You may also pay by credit/debit card **by calling 281-478-2050**.*

3. Rosters:

Rosters must be received before the first game in each tournament and no changes will be made after that. You cannot play on "A" team and then "B" team or vice versa at any time during the tournament. You must play on the original team you started with.

4. *Company Coordinator:*

This is the representative from each company responsible for selecting their team captains, is a committee member with voting rights, responsible for eligibility of all team members, and responsible for all actions of their company/team members.

5. *Team Captain:*

This person is responsible for verification of each member on their team and signing the team roster for their tournament team. Team Captain may play in tournament as well.

6. *Check-In:*

Team check-in occurs at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first game. Please have your picture identification ready, which can be your TDL or work badge. We ask that each athlete check in with his or her team.

7. *Game Time:*

*Game Time is forfeit time. In case of inclement weather, the officials or the Tournament Director will determine if we play. **If needed, we will allow up to a 10-minute grace period prior to the start of the first game and the first game only. All other games may receive a 2 minute grace period prior to the start of the game.***

8. *Forfeits:*

If you do not show up for your first game, you have forfeited that game. If not available for the second game time, you have forfeited the tournament. If a team forfeits or a game is called by the official due to "poor sportsmanship," the company will be penalized 10 points from their total score and not awarded the tournament placement points.

9. *Rain Date:*

*The rain date will be **November 9, 2019.***

10. *Awards:*

*Overall, first (1st) through third (3rd) place companies will receive an award. **In each tournament, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive award medals.***

11. *Protests:*

Protests are recognized by Tournament Director, Assistant Director or Athletic Supervisor only. There will be a protest committee that will determine the outcome. \$75 cash is due at the time of the protest in addition to the protest form to the tournament director. Subtract ten (10) points if your Company is found to have an infraction and the \$75 is not returned.

Cornhole

Place: Jimmy Burke Activity Center, 500 W. 13th street

Rules:

1. The official rules are framed after the American Cornhole Organization.
2. This is a double-elimination tournament. Two divisions: mixed doubles or same doubles.
3. Tournament consists of doubles play – **one male and one female per team or could be two females or two males.**
4. One teammate from each team will be placed at each board; teammates are placed opposite of each other – one at each board – facing one another. One teammate must be on the left side of their board, while the other is placed on the right side of their board on the opposite side.
5. Court Layout – A regulation cornhole court is 8 feet wide and 40 feet long, with a recommended vertical clearance of twelve (12) feet.
6. Cornhole boards are positioned 27 feet from the front edge to front edge of the board.
7. **Scoring:** one (1) point for landing a beanbag on the board, three (3) points for making it through the cornhole. Beanbags that first hit the ground and then land on the board will not count.
8. The first team to score 21 points **OR MORE** (non-bust rules) wins the game (“frame”), and advances.
9. Each **side** takes turns “pitching” four (4) beanbags per teammate. The first team pitches one (1) alternating with the opposing team throwing one (1). Pattern continues. (According to official rules)
10. **Pitchers Box:** Each player stands in what is called the “Pitcher’s Box,” which is found on either side of the board. The player may stand anywhere he or she wishes to pitch the bag, provided that he/she does not: **(1)** exceed 4 feet (width) from their respective side of the board, and **(2)** their leading foot does not pass the front edge of their respective board.
11. **Point Cancellation:** point offset rules are in effect. EXAMPLE: if team Red’s player makes two (2) points on the board (one for each bag on the board), and then team Blue’s player pitches for three (3) points (one for each bag on the board OR one made through the hole), then team BLUE has scores a total of ONE (1) point (3 points (B) minus 2 points (R)).
12. Beanbags made on the board by the other team may be knocked off the board. This will negate the point that the bag made initially.
13. The team that pitches first is determined by which team scored points on the last round. If a draw in points occurs, then the most recent team that went first, goes first again to start the next round.

Rules:

1. There is no Governing body for this.
2. Each Company may enter two teams for a combined score.
3. Each team must be designated before the start of the Race.
4. Each team must have one Female time on the combined score.
5. Each team must have a minimum of four (4) runners complete the race and scores tallied; no limit as to the maximum of runners per team. The top 4 will be calculated (one of which will be the fastest female.)
6. Any deviation from the Course and you will be disqualified.
7. Runners will be running against time.
8. No pacers allowed. All runners with the team/company will count.
9. Water will be on the course at 1 and 2 mile mark and at the refreshment table.
10. You cannot run for the Goblin Gallop. You have to choose one or the other.
11. **PLEASE check-in at least 30 minutes before the start of the race. Team Captains will need to make sure their entire team has checked in.**
12. **Emergency personnel will be available for assistance if required.**
13. **A chipped bib will be assigned to each person running the race. The bib number assigned to the individual running will be labeled on the back. It is extremely important that the runner and bib match up.**
14. Bibs will be available to pick up on Friday, [October 4th](#) located at the Deer Park Community Center [or on race day](#).
15. **The number of teams with names and gender of each team member is due to Debra Culp no later than Wednesday @ 5pm. This is earlier than usual so runner information can be entered into the timing system per request of the timer. Information not submitted on time may not get entered.**

17. Athletes must stay in-bounds. You are out if you step on the out of bounds sideline.
18. Any athlete that is out may retrieve a ball.
19. You may not cross or step on the mid line. If so, you are out.
20. You may not hold the ball for more than ten (10) seconds. Violation and you lose the ball control to the other team.
21. The moment you are out the ball becomes dead.
22. Honor system in place!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
23. When picking up the ball at the center line in the beginning of the game, you must back up behind the “firing” line before you throw the ball at your opponent as well as the other team must be behind line before throwing.
